ICOMOS Travel Scholarship Application Form

ICOMOS New Zealand is pleased to offer a travel scholarship, financially supported by Heritage Management Services of Christchurch, to assist professionals and students in continuing education for the purpose the study of New Zealand heritage conservation and management.

Introduction

ICOMOS, the International Council on Monuments and Sites, is an international non-governmental organisation of heritage professionals engaged in the conservation of places of cultural heritage value and dedicated to the conservation of the world's historic monuments and sites.

The members of ICOMOS New Zealand cover a wide range of professional disciplines concerned with the management and protection of cultural heritage property and include archaeologists, conservation architects, building archaeologists, landscape architects, planners, historians, heritage property managers, heritage managers and administrators.

ICOMOS New Zealand as part of its mandate undertakes education and advocacy to support relevant initiatives for its members. To support and extend these activities ICOMOS NZ is providing a Scholarship up to the value of \$1,000 toward travel costs to encourage and assist heritage professionals and students in New Zealand to attend courses for the purpose of further training or education within the heritage field.

Purpose of Scholarship

To provide financial assistance to a student or practitioner with an interest in pursuing continuing education in the field of NZ Heritage Conservation and Management.

- The scholarship is for up to \$1,000 to be given on an annual basis.
- It is to be a travelling scholarship – national or international – but may include a contribution toward course fees if the travel is under \$1,000 including attendance at seminars, training or educational courses or to undertake research on heritage (built, cultural and landscape), conservation, and archaeology or other activities that support the development and expansion of heritage expertise within New Zealand.
- It may not be used for accommodation.

Eligibility

Applicants who meet the following criteria are eligible for the scholarship.

The candidate:

- Is a full-time or part-time employee or student who has been employed or studying for three years or more within the heritage sector.
- Is a NZ citizen or has permanent residency.

Application Process

Materials to be submitted:

1. Completed application form.
2. A letter of reference or recommendation from a colleague, teacher, mentor or other adult who is not an immediate relative.
3. A typed description (no more than one page, double spaced) addressing the following topics:
 - a. Your career aspirations and why;
 - b. The benefit the ICOMOS Scholarship will have to you the applicant, and New Zealand's heritage practice.
4. Letter of acceptance from the proposed course (if applicable).
5. Budget & timeframe.
6. Means by which the expertise will be shared with the broader heritage community

Deadline

There is no deadline date upon which any application is due. Applications are received at any time, but will be subject to whether an award has been made in that year to date.

Selection Process

Recipients will be selected by the ICOMOS Education and Training subcommittee based on application materials provided.

All scholarship applicants will be notified in writing of the Committee's decision in as timely a way as possible.

Payment will be made to the successful recipient following notification and agreement.

Award

One scholarship annually payable to the recipient/s for travel will be awarded.

A report will be required and the applicant may have the opportunity to make a brief presentation at the ICOMOS AGM.
